




- Having a look on other communities
 - Consultation group for Music
 - Music industry
 - Consultation group on research organisations

What would be a consultation group for libraries?

- an advisory body aiming at (for instance) :
 - Communicating to ISNI-IA specific needs for libraries
 - Making available to ISNI-IA feedbacks on the utility and quality of ISNI-IA's services
 - Analyzing cross-sectors issues and making recommendations to ISNI-IA.
 - Playing a role in the ISNI governance according to ISNI general rules of governance

Questions for this consultation group?

- 1- Including IFLA? Could IFLA play a role?
 - ISNI is an ISO standard, IFLA is the worldwide standardizing body for libraries (delegation from ISO)
- 2- What would be the membership of the group?
 - Libraries and library networks
 - Open to institutions « assimilated to »

- 3- Setting up a facilitation group with volunteers to launch the process?
 - Writing terms of reference ?

Input from libraries for the TAC

Technical advisory committee

- It was decided by the ISNI board on June 2019 to be revived
- Reports to the ISNI Board
- In charge of: management of all aspects of the technical infrastructure and database
 - Data policy documentation
 - Workflows / System and protocols for data exchange between the central database and the Members and RAGs
- Composed by (at least): OCLC, QT, ISNI-IA, representatives from Members / RAGs, from consultation groups

Input from libraries for the QT

- Reports to the ISNI TAC on :
 - Matching processes
 - Merging criteria
 - De-duplication strategy
 - Evaluation of specific assignement policies and strategies, makes recommendation to TAC to take to the ISNI board
 - End users reports
